LISTENING	GRADES

Can give descriptions on a variety of familiar subjects related to their interests.	
Can briefly explain and justify their opinions.	
Can talk in detail about their experiences, feelings and reactions.	
QUALITY OF LANGUAGE	
Knows enough vocabulary to talk about their family, hobbies and interests, school, travel, news and current events.	
Can express himself/herself reasonably and accurately in familiar, predictable situations.	
Can keep a conversation going, but sometimes has to pause to plan and correct what she/he is saying.	
Can use simple expressions politely in a neutral way in everyday situations.
